

DELIVERY OF THE RITUAL

One of the most important duties of the Consul is to assure proper and traditional delivery of the ritual. The Consul should know his ritual and endeavor to prevail on other in the chapter to know likewise.

- a. The ritual must be delivered impressively and with dignity, in a manner to emphasize its teachings, yet not lose its literary quality.*
 - It is far more fitting and impressive to have the ritual team recite their parts from memory than to have the parts read.
- b. Consul should appoint fraters to study the various sections of the ritual and to know them from memory*
 - It is not essential that the various chapter officers assume their respective roles designated in the ritual.
 - It is better to have such parts presented by fraters possessing good voices and diction.
 - Instructions as to formality of presentations must be followed closely.
- c. The retiring Consul must pass by WORD OF MOUTH the passages in the ritual that cannot be committed to print.*
 - The translation of the motto, TAU DELTA PHI
 - The Consul must also point out the exact places in the ritual where the passages fit in.
