

THE CHAPTER SCHOLASTICUS

The Scholasticus serves as the coordinator of the academic and scholarly endeavors of the Chapter.

Goal

- To create a chapter culture which places the academic pursuits of the Fraters at the forefront of the Chapter.

Qualifications

- Be a graduate student who is regularly enrolled in a graduate program at the host institution and who is not a brother of Tau Delta Phi.
- Be a mature and responsible leader who can help the Chapter build a community dedicated to academic achievement.
- Be an advisor of good moral character who preferably has a background or career aspiration within the realm of higher education or education in general.
- If a Chapter House exists, then be a resident while attending graduate school in order to provide oversight in the chapter. This person reports directly to the Executive Director and House Corporation.

Duties

The general responsibilities of the Scholasticus shall be:

- To help monitor grade reports and work with the Scholarship Chairman to certify grade reports for the Fraternity.
- To develop educational programming that meet the needs of the Chapter
- To serve as an advisor on the Board of Alumni Advisors.
